RANCHI: To help students find recruitments in companies across the country, ICFAI university, Jharkhand, is set to start an employability enhancement centre in Ranchi. According to Prof. ORS Rao, vice-chancellor of the university, the university has updated its curriculum and has included latest technological courses like cloud computing and mobile applications for BCA and BTech programs. "In view of the huge potential for jobs in banks in the next few years, a large number of banking electives are introduced for BBA and MBA programs", added Prof Rao.
