

National Seminar on Inclusive Growth through SHGs and FPOs in Rural India in association with NABARD

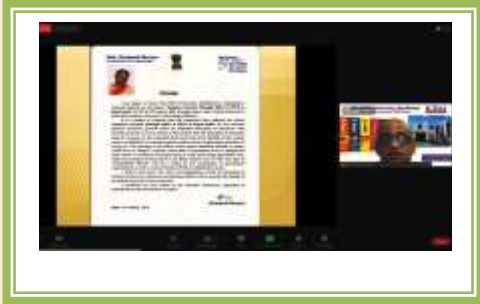
