A three month Paramedics training program is being organized by ICFAI University, Jharkhand in collaboration with Bosch India Foundation to provide entry level skills in health services to rural youth. After completion of 2 months training at the University, students are placed in health care service organizations for on-the-job training/internship.

Even before the completion of the training programme, eighteen out of 25 students received placement offers in reputed home healthcare companies like Portea Medical, Care at Home etc.

A free COVID Medical awareness / advice camp was organized on 21st May 2021, in remote areas of Ranchi under the guidance of Dr. Sajet Kumar, K C Roy Memorial Hospital. Besides medical advice, over 100 Medical Kits with few oxymeter and vapourisers were distributed to the poor people.

The camp was conducted under the supervision by Dr. Smita Sema Devi, Adhyaksh Mahila Samiti, Kathal Tola, Simalia, Ranchi, Dr. Tarakanth Paul, Assistant Professor, ICFAI University, Jharkhand and his wife, Ms Bandhuli Paul Associate, Swan Academy were the active volunteers.
