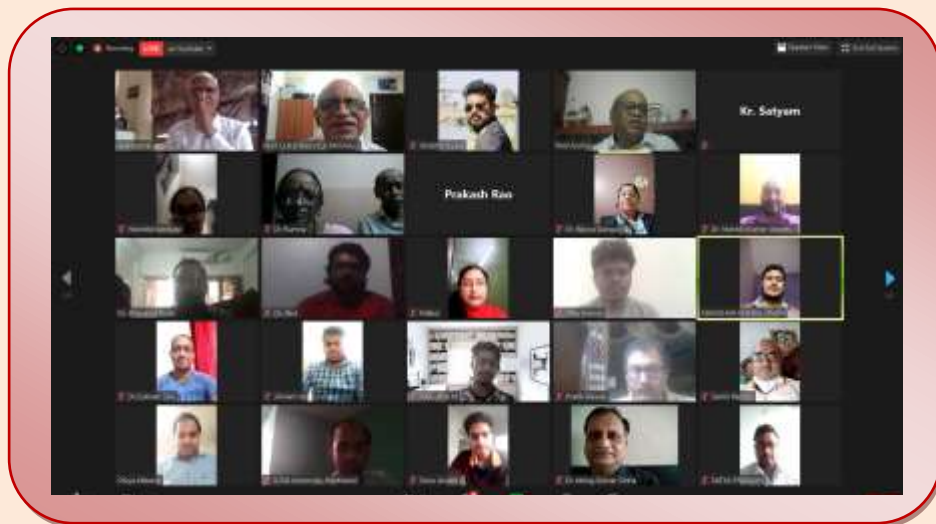

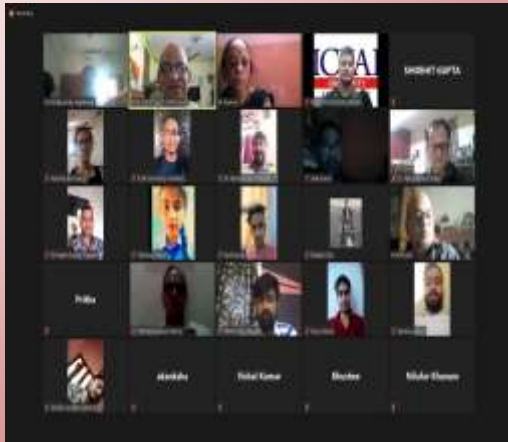


A webinar was organized by the ICFAI University, Jharkhand today on " How to address Mental Health issues during COVID?" . It was addressed by Dr Anil Kumar, former Chief Medical Officer of Ispat MECON Hospital and currently Senior Consultant Psychiatrist at reputed hospitals in Ranchi like MEDICA ,Raj Hospital and Santevita Hospital.



Addressing the students Prof O R S Rao said , " During the COVID-19 second wave , due to faster and wider spread of the virus infection , most of the people are affected by Mental Healthcare issues like anxiety, stress and depression. They include COVID Positive tested patients, attendants as well as others,including children, students ,working women and elderly persons . Students are the most affected ,due to social distancing issues , resulting in closure of college campuses .The objective of webinar is to discuss the causes ,consequences of mental stress and how to mitigate them." "In order to help the students , ICFAI University has decided to set up a virtual counseling centre so that any needed person can contact the counsellors for help ", added Prof Rao.

During a virtual interactive meeting with the students and employees of the university today, Prof O R S Rao, Vice-Chancellor of the ICFAI University asked them to spread positivity, to counter COVID-19. The university plans to create an online platform to facilitate sharing inputs and advice on critical aspects like testing, hospitals, online doctor consultation, supply of medicines etc. on the basis of own experience. This will enable access to reliable information in time and also respond to requests for any needed help immediately



The program started with a video, depicting the selfless sacrifices being made by the healthcare workers and radiating contagious optimism to counter the pandemic.

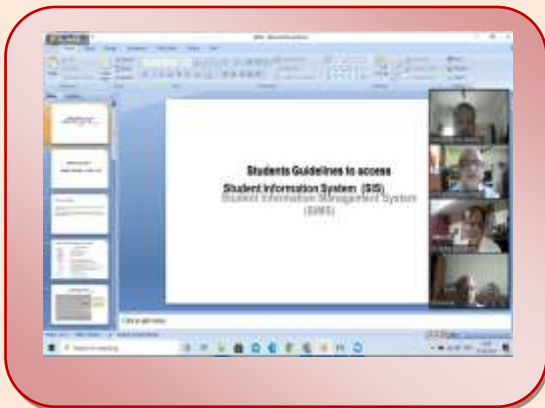
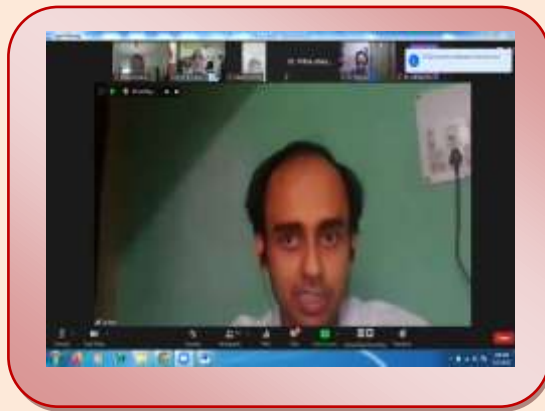
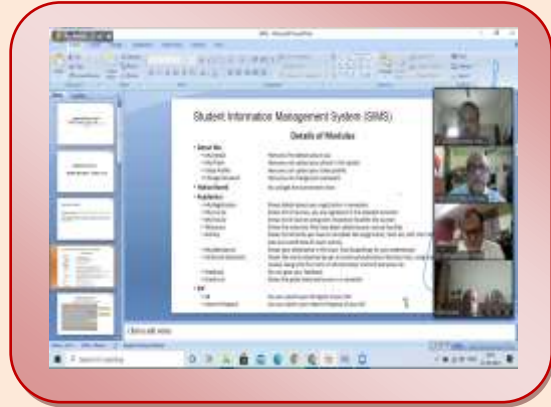
