Ranchi: ICFAI University, Jharkhand, was ranked by Times Higher Education (THE), UK, in its Impact Rankings 2022, wherein the overall rankings included 1,406 universities from 106 countries /regions. The rankings were done on the progress made towards 17 UN's Sustainable Development Goals.
