

Thru the voluntary donations from the Employees of IUJ, "Bhojan Patra" scheme was launched ,wherein Aahar Kits (Rice, Dal, Oil, Sugar, Salt, Imli, Masala etc) are being distributed to the poor families in the surrounding villages of Ranchi district., after taking permission from the Police. The kits were distributed , in small batches, by the Brave and Humane team consisting of Prof. Arvind Kumar, Prof. Sumit Sinha, Prof. Mithilesh Mishra and Dr. Vishal Kumar. Though it is a small gesture on the part of IUJ Employees , it goes a long way to mitigate the hunger of the Poor.

Feedback on Food Distribution initiative of IUJ by the our Ph.D Scholars

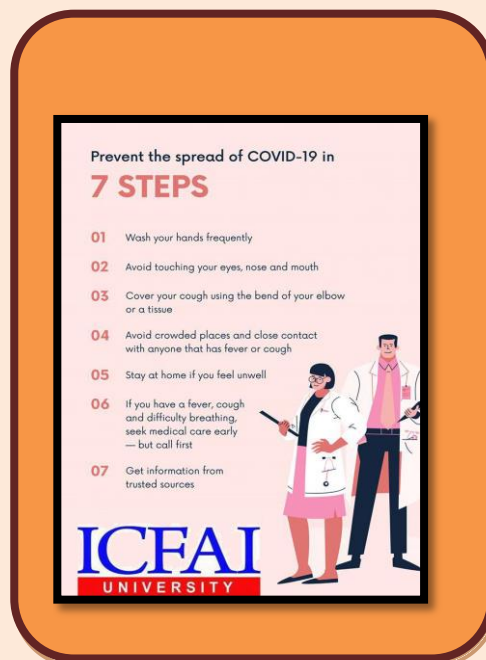

इकफाई विश्वविद्यालय के कर्मचारियों ने बांटी खाद्य सामग्री

रांची। इकफाई विश्वविद्यालय, झारखंड के कर्मचारियों से स्वेचिछक दान कर विश्वविद्यालय द्वारा आहार दान वितरण योजना की शुरुआत की गई। इस योजना के अंतर्गत, आहार किट में चावल, दाल, तेल, चीनी, मक्का, इमली, हल्दी, मसाला आदि जैसे आवश्यक खाद्य पदार्थों पैक किए गए और इस किट को पुलिस अधिकारियों से अनुमति लेकर दलदली स्थित विश्वविद्यालय परिसर के आस-पास के छह गांवों में गरीब परिवारों को वितरित किया। पिछले दो दिनों में रांची जिले के 15 गांवों में विश्वविद्यालय के कर्मचारियों द्वारा आहार दान के किट का वितरण की गयी। इस वितरण यात्रा में 10 से कम लोगों के छोटे समूहों में खाद्य किट वितरित किए ताकि सामाजिक दूरी के संबंध में दिशा-निर्देशों का पालन किया जा सके। वितरण के समय वीर कोड प्रामोण, बूढ़ावस्था के कारण किट नहीं ले जा पा रहा था, तो विश्वविद्यालय के कर्मचारियों ने किट उनके घर जा कर दिये। विश्वविद्यालय के कर्मचारियों में प्रो अरविंद कुमार, रजिस्ट्रार और वरिष्ठ संचालक सरस्य, प्रो सुमित सिन्हा, प्रो मिथिलेश मिश्रा, डॉ विशाल कुमार और डॉ दिलीप कुमार शामिल थे। इस वितरण यात्रा में झारखंड सरकार के अधिकारियों और पुलिस अधिकारियों ने प्रक्रामंद लाभार्थियों को पहचान करने में मदद की और खाद्य किटों के वितरण में सहायता प्रदान की। इनमें से कुछ लाभार्थी प्रवासी श्रमिक और सड़क किनारे के विक्रेता थे और उनके पास राशन कार्ड नहीं थे और सरकार द्वारा राशन की आपूर्ति की सुविधा का लाभ उठाने में असमर्थ थे। इस आहार दान खाद्य किट वितरण के अलावे फेस मास्क भी ग्रामोणों को दान किए गए और कोविड-19 के प्रसार से बचने के लिए बरती जाने वाली सचधानियों पर भी जानकारी दी गई। इस अवसर पर वरिष्ठ सरकारी अधिकारियों में राजेश मिश्रा, अविनाशोर पूर्णोदु, और प्रतिभा झा आदि उपस्थित थे। विश्वविद्यालय के कुलापीत प्रो ओआरएस राय ने आहार दान खाद्य किट वितरण पर कहा कि प्रत्येक खाद्य किट एक नोटों को 10 दिन के भोजन की व्यवस्था को ध्यान में रखकर तैयार किया गया है।



ICFAI University employees distribute Bhojan Paatra Food Kits to needy

RANCHI: Through the voluntary donations from the employees of IUJ, "Bhojan Paatra" Distribution scheme was launched by ICFAI University, Jharkhand. As a part of the scheme, Aahar Kits of essential food items like Rice, Dal, Oil, Sugar, Salt, Iml, Haldi, Masala etc are packed and are distributed to the poor families in six villages surrounding the University campus in Daladali, after taking permission from the Police Authorities.

During the last two days, "Bhojan Paatra" kits were distributed by the University Volunteers in 15 villages of Ranchi district. In order to adhere to the guidelines with regard to social distancing, the University staff traveled to the villages and distributed the Bhojan Paatra kits in small groups of less than 10 people. If any villager, due to old age, was not able to carry the kit, the University volunteers carried them to their houses. The University volunteers included Prof Arvind Kumar, Registrar and Senior Faculty members, Prof Sumit Sinha, Prof Mithilesh Mishra, Dr Vishal Kumar and Dr Dilip Kumar.

Jharkhand Government officials and the Police Officials helped in identifying the needy beneficiaries and extended support in orderly distribution of the Food Kits. Some of the beneficiaries were migrant workers and street side vendors and did not have ration cards and were unable to avail of the facility of ration items supply by Government.

Besides the "Bhojan Paatra" food kit, face masks were also donated to the villagers and briefing was given on precautions to be taken to avoid spreading of COVID-19.

Senior Government officials, Sri Rajesh Mishra, CEO, Mr Avinashor Purnendu, BDO and Smt Pratibha Jha, Food and Drug Inspector, who were present on the occasion, appreciated the efforts of the University to support the poor people in the current crisis situation.

Commenting on "Bhojan Paatra" initiative, Prof O R S Rao, Vice-Chancellor of the University said, " Each Food Kit can take care of the food requirements of a couple for about 10 days. Though it is a small gesture on the part of our employees, it goes a long way to mitigate the hunger of the poor people".
