

So far, 129 online tests were conducted, wherein students took the tests, from home, using lap tops and smart phones, Viva Voce for final year B Tech students, who did internships in the Industry, from early January to 3rd week of March 2020, were conducted online, wherein faculty guides and company guides avaluated

that Swaadhyay is being used by the students, for over 2 hours per day and benefits they received are the facility to go through the study material any time, as per their convenience, short quizzes for self testing etc.

Addressing the online through Conference, Prof O R S Rao, Vice-Chancellor of University said, "We are delighted that our students could continue their studies, uninterrupted, from their homes, most of them at their native villages. We are grateful to our students for their co-operation and to our faculty members that have been working hard to prepare digital content and upload it on Swaadhyay Portal'.
