ICFAI University launches 'SWAADHYAY' to enable students to do self-study from home

SWAADHYAY is a Self-Study Digital Learning Portal, developed by the ICFAI University, Jharkhand, to facilitate its students to learn by self-study, at any time, from anywhere. During the Lock-Down of Jharkhand State, it enables its students to continue their studies, without any interruption.



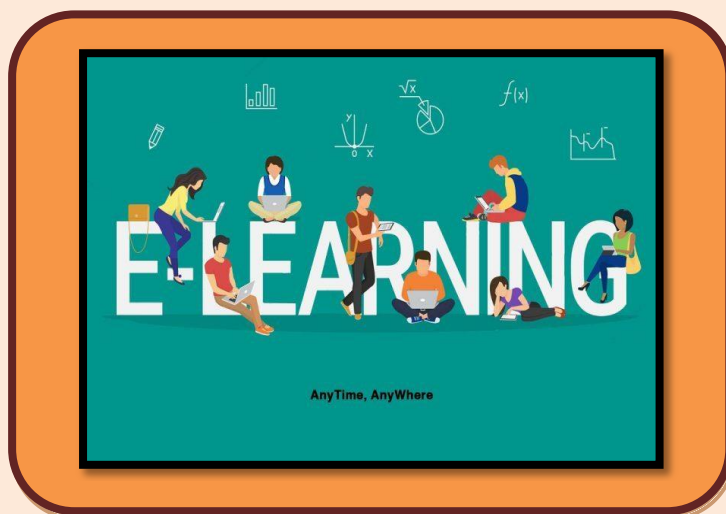
The students of the University can continue their studies for the current semester, by going through the digital course material that is uploaded on the in-house SWAADHYAY Portal. SWAADHYAY portal is different from MOOC Courses like SWAYAM, as it is customized as per the specific requirements of the University. Besides, all the course material is developed by the faculty members of the University

Digital Content for SWAADHYAY was developed by the faculty members of the ICFAI University, Jharkhand as per the curricula of its programs and uploaded to benefit the IUJ students.

Congratulations to faculty members for uploading digital study material for the benefits of the students. It is a matter of pride that Swaadhyay crossed 2,000 uploading of digital educational content. Recording of 47 online class lectures added to Swaadhyay. Also, several e-Books and e-Journal articles (from international publications) were added, as additional reading material, for the benefit of students.



The Digital Content in SWAADHYAY consists of PPTs, Bullet Notes, Case Studies, Video Links, assignments etc. After studying the course material on the portal, students are required to take an online Quiz so that they get feedback on their learning.



All the faculty members of the University, working from home, created and uploaded over 200 digital items in the last 3 days, covering various courses which include Powerpoint Presentations, Video Lectures, Case Studies etc. covering the syllabus for the current semester. After studying the course material on the portal, students appeared in online Quiz. The University also took feedback from the learner on their learning.



Course Material in SWAADHYAY can be accessed by the registered IUJ students, using Desk Top, Lap Top or Smart Phone, using User ID and Password. After studying the course material uploaded during a week, students are required to undergo an online quiz/ test to get feedback on their self-learning. Assignments are also posted on the portal, which need to be done by the students and posted on the portal.

Impressive and enthusiastic response from our students - over 82% of students of 2019 batch accessed the portal within two days of launch. First cycle of internal online tests, scheduled from 1st Apr 2020.
