## Moot Court Competition held at ICFAI University for Law Students

An intra-university Moot Court Competition was organised by the Faculty of Law at ICFAI University, Jharkhand .wherein14 teams, each team consisting of 2 Law Students participated. The themeof the Moot Problem related to "Constitutional Validity of the Sedition offences under Section 124 A of the Indian Penal Code vis-à-vis the Fundamental Right of Freedom of Speech and Expression".

The competition was conducted from 22<sup>nd</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup> Sep 2021 and consisted of Preliminary Round, Semi Final and the Final Round.Sri Prashant Kumar Singh, Member, Bar Council of India and Sri Amit Kumar Das, Senior Advocate, Jharkhand High Court were the judges for the semi finals whereas judges for finals were Sri Rajesh Kumar Pandey, Secretary, Jharkhand State Bar Council, Sri Naman Kamboj, Partner, Litigo Law Chambers and Sri Vivek Singh, Senior Officer-Legal, Oil India Limited.

Welcoming the Panel of Judges and all the participants, Prof. O.R.S. Rao ,Vice-Chancellor of ICFAI University Jharkhand said, "The Moot problem that was selected is of interest to not only Law students but also all the citizens of the country, as it is related to the fundamental right of Freedom of Speech and Expression.
