Industry Expert talk on "Digital Transformation through GIS Technology" held at ICFAI University

GIS has helped even in management of COVID-19 pandemic in areas like determining containment zones, supply chain management of medicines, information on availability of medical care facilities etc.". "GIS Market has been growing rapidly, thereby providing excellent career opportunities to the graduating students in Government as well as in Corporates", added Mr Mathur.
