Constitution Day Celebrated at ICFAI University

70th Constitution Day (Samvidhan Diwas) was celebrated at ICFAI University, in memory of the Day on which Indian Constitution was adopted by the Constituent Assembly in 1949. Shri Prashant Kumar Singh, Member of the Bar Council of India was the Chief Guest and Shri Rajesh Pandey, Secretary of Jharkhand State Bar Council was the Guest of Honor. Before start of the function, the dignitaries paid homage to Bharat Ratna late B R Ambedkar, considered to be the Father of Indian constitution.

Shri Rajesh Pandey exhorted the students to build awareness on legal aspects, like rights and duties of the Citizens, among the illiterates.
