Acing the job interview

Also, in addition to including your professional achievements, think about including information that is relevant to that company's culture.

Page count

A resume has to be summarised into a single page and classified into clear categories. It's best to have a single sheet that one can scan quickly to understand what is the added value that you bring to the table.


