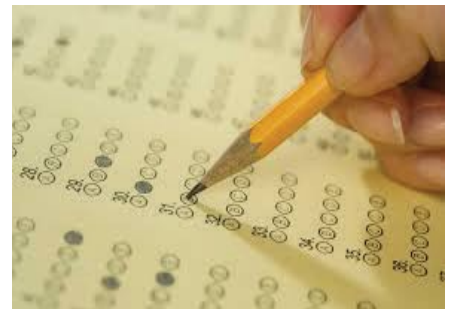

What it takes to join Merchant Navy

Academic **Subodh Devgaonkar** on why a career that needs discipline, physical fitness and technical knowledge continues to excite the youngsters

The vast expanse of un-tamed ocean has always mesmerised humans since the dawn of civilisation. Merchant navy is one of the oldest careers that still enthral the youngsters. This is justified as approximately 90% of the world's merchandise trade by volume passes through sea ports. There are many other reasons including the fact that merchant navy aspirants start working at a very young age.

Cadets swiftly move their way up as they learn while working on the ship. Officers in merchant navy earn enviable tax free salary on foreign going vessels.

OPPORTUNITIES

One can gauge the need for this profession by understanding that India alone boasts of employing thousands of maritime officers and engineers to work on the merchant navy ships.

There are several opportunities to work with international shipping companies. Similarly, there is a huge demand for Indian seafarers, who fare well in communication, adaptation and adjustment in different situations as workforce at sea. Onshore jobs after care-

er at sea are also likely to increase due to increasing growth in this sector. One such example is the implementation of the ambitious Sagar Mala Project initiated by the Ministry of Shipping to promote port-led development in the country. The project worth Rs 8.5 trillion promises to generate around 10,000,000 direct and indirect jobs.

COURSES OFFERED

Aspirants can apply for pre-sea courses in maritime institutes of India, approved by Directorate General of Shipping (DG Shipping), Ministry of Shipping. There are two main courses offered - B.Tech in Marine Engineering-

ring and BSc in Nautical Science. A cadet after completing the 4-year B.Tech (Marine Engineering) degree can join as a trainee marine engineer and then gradually work his or her way up to become a chief engineer on the ship.

Meanwhile, a cadet who completes 3-year Bachelor of Science (BSc) in Nautical Science can join as a deck cadet and then move his or her way up to become master or captain of the ship. One can also opt for several other courses like Diploma in Nautical Science (DNS).

ELIGIBILITY OF WOMEN

Today, women also contribute to the large workforce in the merchant navy. Government offers several scholarships to encourage girls to work in this field and several maritime institutes offer concession in fees to girls.

Institutes approved by the DG Shipping offer top-notch facilities and infrastructure that cater to the requirements of the international shipping companies. (The author is dean, MA-NET (MIT-ADT University))

Will create 1m fresh jobs by 2025: Amazon

'Have Already Created 7L Jobs In India'

Bengaluru: E-commerce giant Amazon on Friday said it will create a million — or 10 lakh — new jobs by 2025. The announcement comes a day after commerce and industry minister Piyush Goyal played down on Thursday the Seattle-based company's \$1-billion investment in India as "not doing a favour (to the country)".

Amazon founder and CEO Jeff Bezos on Wednesday had said he will invest \$1 billion to digitise small and medium businesses and export 'Make in India' goods worth \$10 billion to the e-tailer's global markets by 2025. Amazon said it has created 7,00,000 jobs in India already directly and indirectly over the last six years and the total jobs created by the local arm would stand at 1.7 million by 2025. The direct jobs created by Amazon in India stand at over 60,000. "We've seen huge contributions from our employees, extraordinary creativity from the small businesses we've partnered with, and great enthusiasm from the customers who shop with us — and we're excited about what lies ahead," said Bezos. His comments are of signi-

ficance amid Amazon's tension with government officials, who have been reluctant to meet Bezos, unlike his last visit in 2014 when he met PM Narendra Modi as well. To add to that, just before his arrival in India, the Competition Commission of India (CCI) opened an investigation against Amazon and Walmart-owned Flipkart over issues like deep discounting, favourable terms to select sellers.

A TOI analysis of direct jobs on Amazon's global jobs portal showed there has been a rise of almost 75% in India at 2,235 openings currently compared to 1,236 a year ago. These

numbers of openings — the highest compared to other markets in Asia-Pacific — are across Amazon arms like e-commerce, payments and cloud. Amazon said its job creation is aligned with the Indian government policy that has prioritised this and skilling initiatives — including the training of more than 400 million people by 2022 — in rural and urban areas.

In his letter on the Amazon India, Bezos said he is adding 10,000 e-rickshaws in Amazon's delivery fleet and that it will eliminate single-use plastic from its fulfilment network by June.
